## Seoul Accord and Accreditation and Examination of the JABEE

- Accreditation for the Computing and IT-Related Programs Leading to Bachelor's Degree -

Along with joining Seoul Accord as a signatory in 2008, JABEE has separated accreditation of Computing and IT-related programs from the Engineering disciplines and started to accredit those programs under the Criteria applicable to the Seoul Accord since 2010. The Federation of Managerial Engineering Societies participate examination of Information systems related programs.

JABEE will be applying new criteria from the year 2012. The Seminar is intended to explain how the accreditation of Computing and IT-related program will be implemented under 2012 criteria. At the same time, session will include implementation of the examination for the discipline of Electrical, Electronics and Communications Engineering as relating discipline.

New Criteria, there are "Common Criteria ", which is applied to all disciplines and levels, and Criteria applied for each accreditation levels such as, bachelor or master, and "individual Criteria" for each discipline. In the new Criteria, teamwork, which is already included into 2010 Seoul Accord Criteria, is mentioned, fixation of course hours is terminated, and portrait of the individual to be fostered and ability to be acquired at the time of graduation are separated. Also, reduction of load over accreditation and examination and productive educational improvement is implemented.
